It is with deep sorrow that we report the unexpected passing of Mianbe LeGondje on May 23rd, 2018. Although it is a comfort to know he is with the Lord, we ask that you would **please pray** for his wife and three children, and all who loved him and depended on him.

Since its launching in March 2017, the Romans Project has gained some ground in the country of Chad, spreading like a bushfire southward and eastward. Rev. Mianbe seized every opportunity at meetings

and conferences to introduce people to this ministry. He organized sessions in five cities, but also received calls and requests from over seven other cities. A vibrant plea was sent from a regional church leader some 900 kilometers away from N'Djamena, near the Sudanese border. Mianbe was able to send him some material and gave him some instructions on the phone. Men and women in ministry have also come to his office for documentation on the Romans Project, in order to start their reading assignment.

Please pray for the continuation of the Romans Project in Chad, and for Lord to raise someone who will water the seeds that Rev. Mianbe so passionately, diligently and joyfully planted.
